

Main Street Development 2018 October Update

The works to the Main Street are now well advanced with work continuing in Oxley Street. In early October work was almost completed on the Oxley and Sturt Street corner. These works have included the development of garden beds, pram ramps, tactile paving and the raised crossing. With the warm weather around the corner it is likely the plants will be installed in the new year when the irrigation will be added.



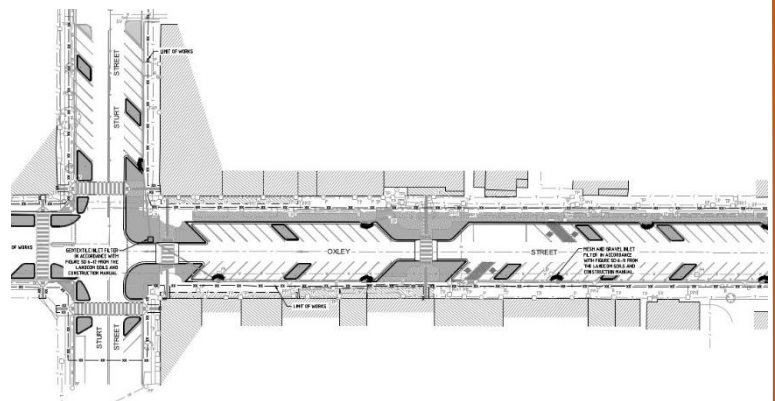
The works are being undertaken largely by local contractors, tradesmen and workers with many of the supplies locally sourced.

Work over the next month will include the widening of the footpath on the northern side of Oxley Street towards the Telstra building to allow for the construction of several shade trellis' and garden beds. It is then planned that the worksite will be moved to the corner of Oxley Street and Richard Street in the lead up to Christmas.



Once again, we thank all residents and business owners for their patience while the work continues and we will endeavour to keep disruption to a minimum.

More detailed plans for the work to be undertaken in the lead up to Christmas will be promoted in November.
